### **Outstanding Business**

- Back-to-school BBQ - Good turnout overall. Almost 100% turnout from most classes. The only feedback was from a parent who was interested in SCC and said that we didn't have a table like we did last year with a volunteer sign-up sheet. The idea for next year was to make a poster and put it on the door explaining what the SCC does and if you are interested who you contact. Had 3 packs of buns left over as well as 7 packs of hotdogs. Will look at cutting back on some hotdogs and getting more chips for next year.
- Welcome back breakfast - Feedback from everyone was really good about the breakfast. Having the syrups in the classroom was a really good idea. Bringing forks for things like this breakfast or shove or hot lunch is going to be a must now because it is just too costly for SCC or school to provide. Knights of Columbus made maybe a little too much food but a lot was frozen for the school and there was also a bunch of food donated to the Red Wings as well.

### **New Business**

- Kare 4 Kidz. Amelia came in to get some ideas about how she can promote Kare 4 Kidz. Currently, Kare 4 Kidz is currently renting the multipurpose room for before and after school care at St. Mike. The company has been in business for about 17 years at a lot of other schools (Regina, etc..) Hours of the program are from 7 am to school start time and the afternoon 3 pm-6 pm. They are an education-based program that has different themes every month and they started in Weyburn in 2022. They have different payment options for different family needs as well as offering summer camps, christmas camps, and PD days. They are looking to add more kids into their Weyburn program so it was suggested that a lot of promotion via social media was a really great way to go. Also looking into getting their childcare name on the Two in One website which is a resource for daycare options for parents.
- 2023/2024 Budget - last year the budget was \$7900. SCC was under budget for expenses. Spent about \$6000 overall last year. In total, there was a small loss overall for the year.  
School awards - \$200. Keep the same as last year  
Music Festival - \$100. Keep the same as last year  
Back to school BBQ - \$1000 - will increase this to \$1200  
Face to Face - \$1200 last year. Increase to \$1300.  
Teacher Appreciation Week & Teacher Lunch - \$1200 last year only spent \$1000. Change to \$1000

Field Day - \$1000 last year only spent \$500. Leave at \$1000

Equipment - \$1000 leave as is

Sacrament gifts & Gr 9 gifts - \$1000 leave as is

Fruit - \$200 leave as is

Misc. \$1000
