### **Existing business**

- Sacraments
  - Melissa S has them and will drop them off at the school
  - Megan will present at the June 2<sup>nd</sup> assembly
- Grade 9 gifts – total of 19
  - Melissa S to try to get crosses before the last Wednesday in June
- National Teachers day is on May 4th
  - Jen and Melissa B delivered goodies; lots of positive comments and was appreciated
- Library funds
  - Original request was \$3,000
  - Previously committed \$1,500 and would re-visit once we knew results of fundraiser
  - Tabled until fundraiser report
- Ice cream treat day – June 27
  - 306 Creamery
  - Cones 2.25/student; freezies are \$1/student
  - \$1,000 budgeted
  - Allyson made motion to go forward with providing ice cream treat for all staff and students, Melissa S Seconded. Carried

### **SRC Report – Sabrina on behalf of SRC**

- Spirit days have been occurring
- Yearbook is in full swing and the link to order went out to parents
- Glow dance for grade 7-9 which they are very excited about

### **Principal's Report - Dean**

- Went through the upcoming events (list was provided)
- Discussed budget cuts a bit; they are expecting positions to be cut but not sure what that looks like yet as there are lots of delays.
  - About a 5% operating budget cut
- Student numbers are up from the start of the year but down where they would like to be. Will be sitting at approximately 500 students next year

- Approximately 34 K registrations
- All Grade 8 are staying; losing about 4 grade 7's, and 12-15 grade 6's based on the surveys
- Going to continue with the hockey program next year
  - Moving to grade 7 group to try and retain kids as they feel they will lose more grade 6's for next year if they don't
  - Will be a slightly different program with less outcomes being done on the ice

#### **Hot lunch – Megan**

- Melissa discussed budget and we are under budget by about \$2,300 so discussed pizza party
- One slice/kid would use up BP credits plus cost about \$100
- Discussion was held on other options such as more pizza or chips and juice box to go with it
- Dean mentioned using the \$500 remaining from the Mental Health grant towards this
- Jen and Kaitlyn to coordinate drinks and chips; Megan will coordinate pizza
- Planned date about June 15
- Next year will have to pick dates based on school plan

**Jen motions to use BP credit for pizza from Boston Pizza and purchase chips and juice boxes as well as additional amount for pizza that the credit doesn't cover up to \$500 from SCC. Kennedy seconds. Carried**

#### **Fundraising Report**

- Growing Smiles
  - Profit of about 1,700 which was an 18% profit
- Mabels Lables
  - Allyson applied for this and got it set up
  - 20% on any labels that are purchased
  - It will run from June – June
  - Send us a cheque once/month
  - Going to attach to the supply lists that go out to the students

#### **Treasurer Report – Melissa**

- Went over budget to actual; excess of about \$2,300
- A few things to go through still such as sacraments, books, awards
- Balance approximately \$17,000

#### **Library funds**

- Discussion held included
  - Could promote our next fundraiser that we do towards the library funds
  - Isn't a huge rush for funds as we are nearing the end of the school year
  - Request is still there
