Outstanding Business:

- Educational Plan 2023-2030. There has been no updates. Revisit in November or December to see if there are any results available

New Business:

- One School One Book is an SCC initiative that has been happening in more and more schools. It is a way for the SCC to be more involved in the learning plan for the school. It would be every family in the school gets 1 book that they read together as a family following the guide the school provides for how many pages to read at a time etc. Teachers would then tie in age-appropriate lessons at school in regards to the book. Lesson plans would have to be made by the teachers as it didn't seem that there were any books out there that we could get that would have lessons plans already made up. Budget was roughly calculated to approx. \$4000. This would be about \$2000 - \$2500 for a paperback book for families (300-350 families). And then possible a celebration after book is done for the school. (Movie night was an idea). This would be a large cost to the school but would promote the connection between the school on family as an annual event. Discussion was tabled as more information is to be gathered with possibly reaching out to SCC committees that have done this.

Committee Reports

SRC Report – Dean

- SRC has met and has 57 students join this year
- Grade 9 students are leaders of the following committees: Spirit Days, SCC & Religion, Dances & Events, Outdoor Sign, Indoor Calendar, Advertising, Canteen & Assemblies.

Principal Report – Dean

- Counsellors are in the building this week due to a traumatic event regarding a staff member. Counsellors introduced themselves to the school at a gospel assembly so that kids and staff would know who they are and where to find them.
- Upcoming events for the school:
 - Oct 24th Staff Faith Day for staff to go out and do volunteer work in the community. Some places that they are going to is McKenna Hall, Family Place, Calvary Baptist Church, Humane Society & St. Vincent Church to help with odd jobs
 - Oct 26th Picture Retake Day. Some of the class pictures didn't have the best quality so LifeTouch is going to identify which class pictures could be better and retake them.
 - Oct 28th is the Communithon which has quite a few classes participating.
 - School Clothing store is open from Oct 11 – Nov 4th
 - Nov 21st – 23rd Student Led Conferences will be held in person this year after a hiatus due to covid. There is still the option to do virtual again later on.

Hot Lunch Report – Jen

- \$2770 deposited – 271 regular meals, 3 gluten free meals & extras were purchased
- Oct 26th & 27th are the hot lunch days
- Only thing noted was if staff could circle the day they want the hot lunch.

Fundraising – Allyson & Melissa S

- \$197 Mabels Labels cheque was received. No other order since cheque was received. Will possibly starting sending Mabels Labels Promos to Dean for it to be put on the Facebook page.
- Creative Eats Cheesecake was well received. 950 orders with a profit of \$2200. Melissa S is following up with Creative Eats on a definite date of delivery but probably looking at 2-3 weeks. Will either organize at Bourassas or at school, to be determined.
- 50/50 idea was talked about. It would be very little work for SCC as it is all online. Only condition is that it has to go into a non-school division bank account (all this info was gathered from Stoughton School). This fundraiser could potentially resemble gambling though so would have to look more in to it.
