Committee Reports

SRC Report

- The SRC weren't in attendance this meeting, but Sabrina let us know they are busy getting ready for all the events / spirit days they have planned in October.
- They are also supporting the volleyball tourney coming up by working at the canteen.

Principals Report - Sabrina

Hot Lunch – Erika

- There were around 80 portions of leftover lasagne from hot lunch! It is being stored in the freezer for any kids that need it at school. SCC funds for extra meals in the office is no longer needed at this time.

- Mentioned getting Angelo at McKenna a thank you card / gift. Which turned into a discussion of SCC creating a Christmas photo / card to share with our sponsors and on the school's social media page. We also discussed doing SCC member features again on Facebook, so everyone is to write a little blurb and submit a family photo to Sabrina to post on Facebook.

Fundraising Report- Kiteen

- McKenna Hall soup fundraiser has been confirmed for February 2025! Discussed that the soup forms will be sent out to all parents on Monday, February 3rd and the deadline to submit orders will be Monday, February 10th. Kiteen (with the help of Taylor, Sheena, and Allyson) will compile the order forms and give to Angelo no later than Wednesday, February 12th so he has a full 2 weeks to prepare orders.
- The fundraising committee also decided on a Purdy's Chocolate fundraiser this year. Kiteen to register the school and share with the office in early November. Kiteen to investigate if chocolate gets shipped to the school or directly to participants homes.
- Calli let us know we missed the deadline for October grants but will check for other grants that come up and apply for those that are applicable to our school.

Treasurer Report - Taylor

- \$18,200 is currently in the bank account (the iPads expense hasn't been taken out yet).
- We lost around \$450 on the October McKenna hot lunch.
- Spent \$1,129 for back-to-school BBQ. Taylor mentioned we may need to add more into the budget next year to purchase plates for this event.
